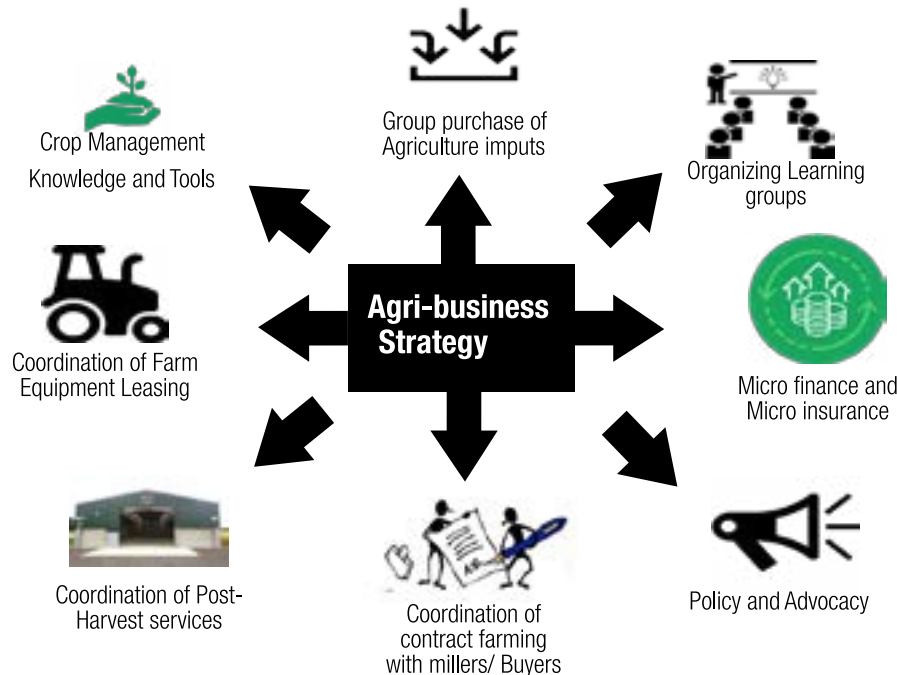
F04ACP in Eastern Africa region

The direct target group are smallholder farmers belonging to 14 National Farmer Organizations (NFOs) across eight countries in Eastern Africa region (Burundi, Djibouti, DR Congo, Kenya, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania and Uganda) involved in Cassava, Irish potato, Livestock, Maize and Soybeans value chains. It is anticipated that 40% of participants will be women.

Implementation modalities

EAFF integrated approach to facilitate economic services to farmers



Market-driven approach. This is operationalized through the central role that EAFF and its membership plays in aggregating farmers into membership based organizations and through collective marketing enable them access to stable markets, catalyse accessing credit and productivity enhancement.

Partnership development. That entails EAFF and members are coordinating effectively as well as mobilizing public, development and private sector partners to support EAFF and her members to be able to achieve the above mentioned objectives.

Subsidiarity. Most activities will be implemented and services will be delivered at the lowest possible level. FOs will be responsible for delivering proximity services and making available information on achievements. NFOs will play the role of convener and facilitator of multi-stakeholder local processes.
